All contestants will arrive by 10:45am. Come Dressed & Ready to Go.

Please do not arrive too early, the stage is being set up in the morning prior to our event.

<u>PAGEANT LOCATION:</u> Bloomfield – Corner of Liberty Avenue & Gross Street. We are on the First Commonwealth Stage one block from West Penn Hospital. (End of the festival booths on the West Penn Hospital Side) (Close to 5001 Liberty Ave) **PARKING** Available on side streets. (West Penn Hospital Lot)

PAGEANT REQUIREMENTS: Showmanship, personality, confidence, and a spirit for Little Italy Days. Contestants complete a stage model, a personal introduction & a 2 question interview.

<u>DRESS:</u> <u>ANY STYLE OF DRESS or FASHION OUTFIT.</u> Contestant's choice, Examples of attire: (flower girl dress, Sunday best, party, pageant, prom, homecoming attire)

STAGE EVENT: contestants will introduce themselves, "Hello, my name is

- MODEL/STAGE WALK: Contestants will do a graceful, slow walk on stage, adding turns and any poses of their choice for on-stage modeling portion.(VIDEO EXAMPLE WILL BE POSTED ON THE MISS LITTLE ITALY FB PAGE)
- 2. ON STAGE QUESTIONS: Marianne will attempt to make every child feel comfortable. Marianne is available to chat by phone with contestants and/or parents prior to event.

ON STAGE: 1-3yr

1. ONE ADULT: can escort child on stage to model and share their name and why they are unique and want to be Miss Baby Little Italy.

<u>OUTDOOR EVENT:</u> Free to Watch. Every family takes care of their own child. Please bring whatever is necessary to wait in the sun. Umbrella, sunscreen, hats, bottled water. There is almost no shade and minimal space. <u>SEATING:</u> Seating is limited. **Please bring a CHAIR if concerned.**

<u>ORDER OF EVENTS:</u> We will start with the youngest divisions and keep moving quickly to complete all divisions. We cannot give designated times of appearance due to the strict window of stage time. If a contestant **ARRIVES TOO LATE** or a NO **SHOW**, there are NO REFUNDS. We cannot allow onstage appearance if the age division is complete. Score sheets have already been tabulated.

<u>CODE OF CONDUCT for Contestants, family & friends</u>: This event is not a place to show negative resentment in any way. This is based on a brief interaction, little criteria and human opinion. Please do not approach our judges or director. Judges' results are final. It is always so close. Every year, the judges say the same thing: They wish they could pick everyone! The pageant will NOT accept or acknowledge negativity. We are trying to celebrate family, heritage, and the small businesses and vendors.

CHANGE: (We allowed back-to-back entries for winners due to the Covid cancellation) Last year it was switched back to our original rules below. WINNERS ARE NO LONGER ALLOWED TO ENTER THE SAME AGE DIVISION DURING THE YEAR OF THEIR WIN. Will need to wait one full year. WINNERS CAN enter if moving up in an age division.
